## Haunting Breaks at Henry's hunting lodge

Paranormal company Haunting Breaks is offering groups the chance to take a scary trip to Bolebroke Castle, once the hunting lodge of Tudor King Henry VIII.

Group packages start at £140, and can feature dinner in the King's great hall, overnight accommodation and breakfast. Groups also have the option of taking in a ghost hunt, riding the ghost train through the castle grounds, plus practicing table tipping and glass divination, activities associated with the world of the paranormal.

The castle is the sight of many reported ghostly sightings, including the figure of a headless woman thought to be the spirit of Anne Boleyn, one of the King's six wives.

The castle is also home to a Henry VIII exhibition at a cost of £4 per person. Groups that want the authentic feel on their visit can even hire Elizabethan costumes or host an Elizabethan banquet.
